

At the moment they are gathering some materials from the Churches since they were also asked to make contributions of remaining bricks and river sand. During the Projects Committee meeting, we agreed to make an extension of the fence so that it can be big enough. Instead of building a new house for the cook and his family, the parishioners are going to renovate an existing house near the maize mill. This will still have the cook significantly closer to the rectory.

We will also have a trip to Namalaka in August to visit our sister parish.
