### **THIS WEEK ON FORMED**

FORMED has put together an interesting series called "The Search." It is seven episodes so far and takes on questions like, *The meaning of life: where am I going and what happens when I die?* All from a Catholic perspective and give insight as to how to explain our faith to others. This week we look at the fourth video, "Who is Jesus?" <https://watch.formed.org/the-search/videos/theseearch-ep5> "But who do you say that I am?" Check it out!

FORMED is also doing a series on the Sacraments. This one is on How to receive Holy Communion well: <https://watch.formed.org/carousel/videos/formed-now-how-to-receive-communion-well>

February 17th is Ash Wednesday! Here is a quick video from Fr. Mike Schmitz about Ash Wednesday: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=hPTcMWpHfKk>, and another one on picking what you will do for Lent: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=XmwKpcJKLt8&t=7s>. This focuses on what is arbitrary vs. necessary as you decide what to give up for Lent. Challenge yourself to LIVE Lent and not just observe Lent! There are numerous short videos or podcasts to watch every day or once a week. We will be starting the Consecration to St. Joseph on the Monday before Ash Wednesday, maybe that is something you family could do. We have the little black books available for daily reflection. Maybe you or your family could join us for Stations of the Cross on Friday evenings? How will you look different when you get to Easter?

We have many parishioners who began this study at the beginning of 2021, and we have some who have just started - it is not too late to catch up! The Bible in a Year with Fr. Mike Schmitz is with Ascension Press and each episode is about 20 minutes. They are Podcasts so you can listen from practically anywhere! Here is the link for the reading plan:

## ST. BRENDAN GARDENS

March will be the start of our 2021 monthly work parties to beautify the church grounds. In fact, because Easter is in early April, we will actually have two work parties before then: **Saturday, March 6**, and **Saturday, March 27**. Feel free to join us on one or both of those mornings. In addition to the general cleanup of the grounds, we'll also have a project to work on this year: cleaning up the gravel pathway on the east side of the church building, adding new stones and mulch in that area, and planting more ferns alongside the pathway.

If you have any small sword ferns that you would like to donate from your yard, we certainly could use them. Also, as you start working in your own gardens and need to divide plants or just dig up new seedlings, please consider potting them up for our fundraising plant sale in April—they would be much appreciated. Please bring rakes, shovels, and other gardening tools you might need on March 6. (For the work on the east side, we could really use a wire "sifter" to separate gravel and soil, if anyone has one). Any questions? Please contact Anneliese at 425-770-2103.

## SOS—A few highlights from 2020:

- We had 25 volunteers in the day-old groceries Gleanings & hot meals initiative of the SOS Program. Seven are Knights from Bothell Council 6686. (Note: Many other people volunteer for SOS in other capacities. Larry Pomada is the program manager).
- On-site hot meal preparation and cooking was cancelled ca. February 2020 when COVID-19 began to spread throughout Washington State.
- A temporary agreement was struck to continue SOS operations, via the Northshore Senior Center Kitchen preparing ~120 hot meals each week, to be transported to St. Brendan for the Thursday SOS meal and distribution to the following area homeless camps:
  - New Bethlehem Project (Kirkland/Redmond)
  - The Landing (Kirkland)
  - New Ground (now Youth Haven) (Kirkland)
  - Camp Unity (Transient - mostly Woodinville)
- On May 21 we began recording the Gleanings food weight and value, as well as volunteer hours and miles. (This was first suggested by Glenn Podany.)
- May 21 - December 2020, we collected 36,117 lbs. of food (value over \$55,000). We logged 1,183 hours and 5,757 miles, collecting food from PCC Bothell and the Holy Innocents Food Bank, and distributing hot prepared meals to the above homeless shelters.

### *Lenten Discipline*


The Church calls all Catholics to observe Lent through the ancient disciplines of fasting and abstinence from meat by:

✧ **Fasting** on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday for all who are 18 through 59 years of age. Fasting consists of only one full meal with two smaller meals allowed if necessary.


✧ **Abstaining** from meat for those 14 years of age and older on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all Fridays of Lent

*The Parish Office will be closed Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter Monday.*

*There will be no morning Mass or confessions on Monday, April 5<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday, April 7<sup>th</sup>*
