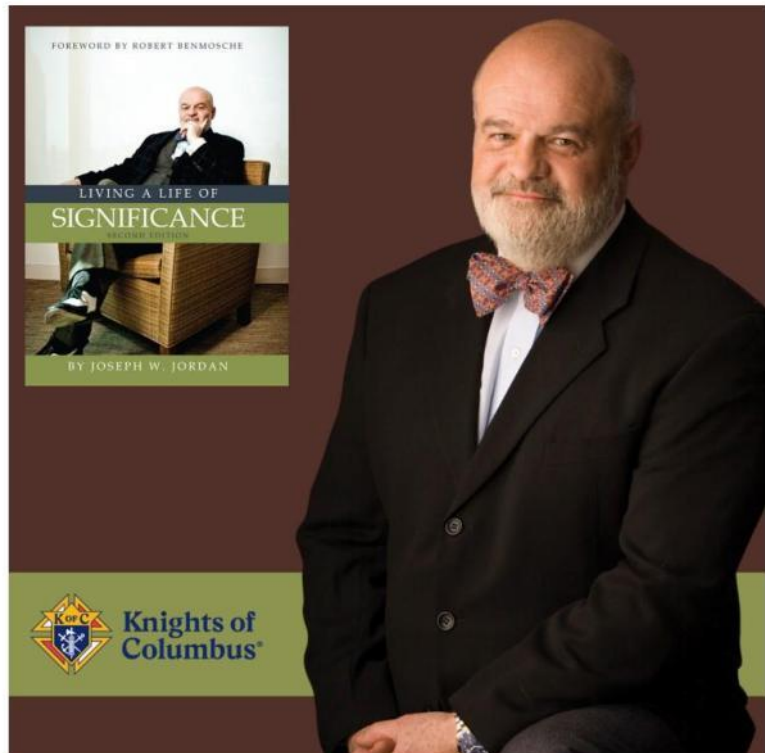

Lenten Discipline

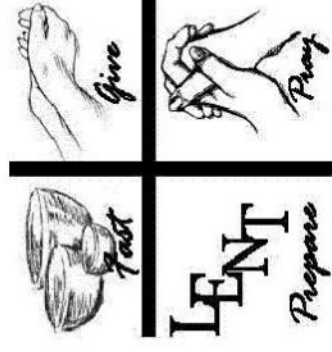
The Church calls all Catholics to observe Lent through the ancient disciplines of fasting and abstinence from meat by:

✧ **Fasting** on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday for all who are 18 through 59 years of age. Fasting consists of only one full meal with two smaller meals allowed if necessary.


✧ **Abstaining** from meat for those 14 years of age and older on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all Fridays of Lent

The Parish Office will be closed Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter Monday.

There will be no morning Mass or confessions on Monday, April 5th and Wednesday, April 7th
