

The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed for adoration, Fr. Wichert will be hearing confessions, and we'll have moments of silence, directed meditations, and hymns.

TENEBRAE WEDNESDAY— "Tenebrae ("shadows" or "darkness") is a Holy Week service that is at least 1,000 years old. Like the "lessons and carols" services familiar at Christmas, Tenebrae consists of hymns and readings, the ones proper to Lauds and Matins for the days of the Triduum. The church is lit with 15 candles and are extinguished one by one until the nave is left in darkness. At that point, a loud noise ("strepitus") would be produced - sometimes by slamming a hymnal or other book shut, sometimes by stomping on the floor – symbolizing the earthquake after Christ's death." In many Eastern European countries, it is a tradition to have a basket of food blessed on Holy Saturday or Easter Sunday. In Poland, for example, the blessing of the baskets is known as święcenie pokarmow wiełkanocnych, a practice dating to the 15th century or earlier, and one which is still maintained by most families in Poland (and to some extent in other countries).

The food items in the Easter basket, as well as at the Easter Sunday breakfast when the blessed food is eaten, have special significance. Although every family might have its own traditions when it comes to the Easter baskets, many make sure to include enough food so every family member can have a bite of all the blessed foods after Mass on Easter Sunday. Blessing of Easter baskets in the Eastern Europe tradition will take place at St. John Vianney on Holy Saturday, April 8th at noon. All are welcome!

Spiritual Adoption Update - Two Months - I'M DANCING!! - The baby is making rapid progress developing all her external and internal organs. During the second month baby teeth form and her fngers and toes are developing. Ears, nose, lips and tongue can now be clearly seen. Even her brain waves can now be recorded. The skeleton changes from cartilage to bon. The central nervous systm is now functioning and so forty muscle sets begin thier first exercises. By 8 weeks all body systems are present and the baby is called a "fetus", a Latin word meaning "little one" or "young one". Ultrasound reveals that this little one can now spring and jump - her first dance steps!
