

## GIVING TREE: NOTE OF GRATITUDE

The Giving Tree team wants to take a moment to thank The St. Brendan Community for their support again this year.

The *Knights of Columbus* has partnered with us as well the past couple years to help make sure all our requests are being met and this year was no different—they came in at the last minute and helped us fill unfilled tags with a generous donation.

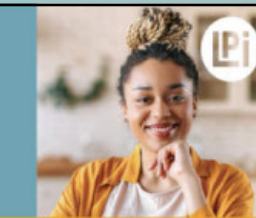
