

ST. VINCENT DE PAUL NEWS

Our St. Brendan school students are studying a virtue every month. Saint of the Month: St. Vincent de Paul Virtue: Charity-loving God with all your heart, mind, and strength, and loving your neighbor as yourself. He was born to a poor peasant family in France on April 24, 1581. He studied under the Franciscans and was such a good student that a wealthy family hired him to be a tutor. He earned enough money to pay for a university education studying Theology. Vincent was ordained to the priesthood in 1600. His early years of priesthood were filled with excitement. In 1605, he was traveling to Narbonne on a ship when he was captured by slavers. He was taken to Tunis and sold into slavery! Two years later he managed to escape and made his way back to France. St. Vincent eventually ended up in Rome, where he became a chaplain to the Count of Goigny and was placed in charge of distributing money to the poor. This appointment appears to have been the springboard to his lifelong mission of preaching and providing relief to the poor. He established hospitals for the poor and ministered to convicts. The need to evangelize and assist these souls was so great. He could not do it alone so he founded the Ladies of Charity, a lay institute of women, to help, as well as a religious institute of priests - the Congregation of Priests of the Mission, commonly referred to now as the Vincentians. The Vincentians remain with us today with nearly 4,000 members in 86 countries. St. Vincent is sometimes referred to as "The Apostle of Charity" and "The Father of the Poor". The feast day for St. Vincent, the patron of all charitable societies, is **September 27**.

We have a St. Vincent de Paul society here at our own parish. This group helps the poor by distributing food and other essentials to the needy. They also collect gifts for needy families in our parish and community through the Christmas Giving Tree. Feel free to contact them to find out how you can be like St. Vincent de Paul and help the needy in our own community. 
