



SPOTLIGHT ON SERVING OUR SAVIOR (SOS)

It is 8:30 Thursday morning, and the sound of metal rolling shutters being pushed up echoes in the narthex. The familiar sound in the parish kitchen that signals the start of the day for St. Brendan's Serving Our Savior (SOS) volunteers. For the past 40 years, SOS has prepared and delivered food to those in need in Bothell, as well as neighboring towns such as Woodinville, Kirkland, and Redmond. The kitchen is bustling with chopping, washing, boiling, sizzling, and chattering. With just a little over a dozen volunteers, they have provided meals to an estimated 5,000 people each year —from grocery gleaning and shopping, to prep work, cooking, and distribution. The additional funds donated by parishioners have helped tremendously in purchasing supplemental food and supplies for various shelters in the area. New volunteers, as well as donated items (see previous page, left margin), are always welcome. Stop by and say "Hello!" this Thursday.
