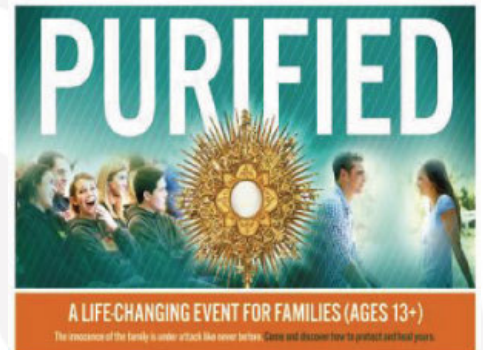

SPIRITUAL ADOPTION UPDATE—Our spiritually adopted babies are now eight months old. Everything in the baby's body is preparing for entry into the world. The brain and nervous system are maturing, a process that will continue long after birth. The baby's limbs are becoming smooth and plump, and the skin is a healthy color. The fingernails are growing past the baby's fingertips. From the mother's immune system, the baby is acquiring immunity to many infections as the protective antibodies in the blood pass through the placenta into the mother's blood. The immunity lasts for a few months after birth, until the baby develops resistance to illnesses on it's own. Although the baby doesn't breathe, the baby does make breathing movements to practice for the real thing, and hiccups occasionally. The baby has a regular daily pattern of activity and rest. The amount of amniotic fluid reaches its maximum this month—about two pints on average. The volume of fluid will diminish somewhat as delivery nears. With a normal weight of five pounds and measuring a little more than 17 inches from head to toe, it will only be possible for the baby to turn from side to side—no more somersaults! The baby will now most likely settle into a head-down position.
