

YOUNG AT HEART SENIORS

In the late 1950s, Rachel Carson, a noted marine biologist and science writer, turned her attention on the impact of synthetic pesticides on the environment. Her book, *Silent Spring* (1962), documented harm done by the chemicals and, of course, faced much opposition by the companies producing pesticides. Nevertheless, this book had a powerful impact on the public's awareness of environmental issues and led to the banning of DDT and other pesticides as well as the formation of US Environmental Protection Agency.
