

Spiritual Adoption Update - Three Months - "I'm three inches!" "I can suck my thumb now!" The baby now sleeps and awakens. Fingernails and toenails form and he has his own unique set of fingerprints. Sensitive to touch, he will tightly grasp an object placed in the palm of his hand. He breaths amniotic fluid to help develop and strengthen the respiratory system, but he gets the oxygen he needs through the umbilical cord. He can now squint, swallow and move his tongue. In fact, early this month - around week 9 - he began to suck his thumb.


