

Spiritual Adoption Update - Six Months: I'm fourteen inches long! I am sitting up straight now! By the sixth month the baby's oil and sweat glands are functioning; these help to regulate body temperature. A white filmy layer covers the baby and protects her delicate skin from the surrounding amniotic fluid and from scratches as she twists and turns. This waxy substance, a sort of natural skin cream, will be quickly absorbed into her skin soon after she is born. She can now respond to sound. Her lungs are fairly well developed, and she would stand a good chance of survival if born at this time.
