

OLIVE WOOD CARVINGS FROM BETHLEHEM

We are having olive wood carvings available to purchase after all Masses the **weekends of October 14/15**. The proceeds are to support Christian Catholic families in the Holy Land since it is the major source of income for them there. More than 75 families in Bethlehem Hand carved these items. They are very beautiful and unique items—Nativities, Crucifixes, Rosaries, Statues. The Christian population has dropped from 22% to less than 2% in the past two decades.
