

EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL-YEAR 2 | JESUS IS CALLING US DEEPER-HE PROMISES TO RESTORE AND RENEW HIS PEOPLE-We are in the midst of a 3-year Eucharistic Revival throughout our country. Year 1's focus is on the Archdiocesan level. This year the focus is on increasing our awareness of the Eucharist in our nation's parishes. It will culminate with the 10th National Eucharistic Congress in Indiana on July 17-21, 2024-the first one to be held in the United States in 83 years! Between now and July, we will be: increasing the times of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and Benediction; having classes throughout the upcoming year during the Women's/Men's Group and Lent; and having a Eucharistic Procession on the feast of Corpus Christi in June.
