

### **TENEBRAE WEDNESDAY**

"Tenebrae ("shadows" or "darkness") is a Holy Week service that is at least 1,000 years old. Like the "lessons and carols" services familiar at Christmas, Tenebrae consists of hymns and readings, the ones proper to Lauds and Matins for the days of the Triduum. The church is lit with 15 candles and are extinguished one by one until the nave is left in darkness. At that point, a loud noise ("strepitus") would be produced - sometimes by slamming a hymnal or other book shut, sometimes by stomping on the floor - symbolizing the earthquake after Christ's death." ### Here is the corrected information for Hallow App. All parishioners have the App for free through Pentecost. Holy Day Package – Hallow

- 1. Type in St. Brendan-our parish will pop up.
- 2. Then click Redeem Offer.
- 3. It will then give you the QR code >>> to use or if you are on your phone it will take you to the site. Just follow the instructions.
- 4. A couple of issues that people have had:



*I am required to do a 7 day trial*—Typically, there are two reasons that people see the 7 day trial instead of getting full access. The first reason is if they do not register through the Holy Day page in advance. Sometimes, people think that the holy day page is just one way to get access. Unfortunately, that is not the case. They will not be able to utilize their premium access except through first registering on the webpage.

The second reason this happens is if someone registers on the holy day page through one option (phone, email, google registration, or apple registration), and then they try to access their account a different way.


