TENEBRAE WEDNESDAY

Col 3:1-4

"Tenebrae ("shadows" or "darkness") is a Holy Week service that is at least 1,000 years old. Like the "lessons and carols" services familiar at Christmas, Tenebrae consists of hymns and readings, the ones proper to Lauds and Matins for the days of the Triduum. The church is lit with 15 candles and are extinguished one by one until the nave is left in darkness. At that point, a loud noise ("strepitus") would be produced – sometimes by slamming a hymnal or other book shut, sometimes by stomping on the floor – symbolizing the earthquake after Christ's death." Join us on **Wednesday, April 13, 8:30PM**.


