

SPIRITUAL UPDATE-THIRD MONTH—"I CAN SUCK MY THUMB NOW"—In January many of our parishioners spiritually adopted newly conceived babies, making a commitment to pray daily as these babies grow and develop. These babies are now 12 weeks old and they are 3 inches. They can now sleep and awaken. Fingernails and toenails form and they each have their own set of fingernails. Sensitive to touch, they will tightly grasp an object placed in the palm of their hand. They breathe amniotic fluid to help develop and strengthen their respiratory system, but they get the oxygen they need through the umbilical cord. The babies can now squint, swallow and move their tongue. In fact early this month. around week 9, they began to suck their thumb.
