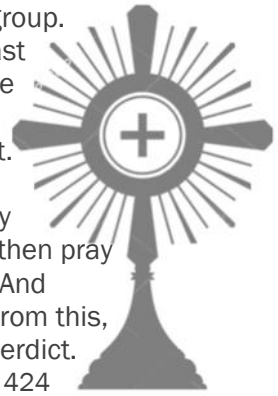

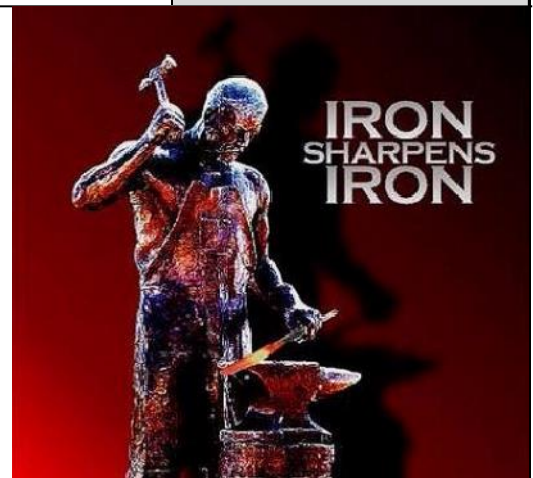
IRON SHARPENS IRON
