

BLESSING OF THROATS

St. Blaise was bishop of Sebaste in Cappadocia, and was martyred about A.D. 316. While in prison he performed a wonderful cure on a boy who had a fishbone lodged in his throat and who was in danger of choking to death. From this account we have the longtime custom of invoking the Saint for all kinds of throat trouble.

After blessing the candles on the feast of St. Blaise, the celebrant holds two candles fastened like a cross to the throat of the person kneeling before him, and says:

By the intercession of St. Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from every malady of the throat, and from every possible mishap; in the name of the Father, and of the Son, + and of the Holy Spirit.

R. Amen.



SOS-DRIVERS NEEDED


