

#### Individual Sacrament of Penance

FASTING on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday for all who are 18 through 59 years of age. Fasting consists of only one full meal with two smaller meals allowed if necessary.

ABSTAINING from meat for those 14 years of age and older on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent.
