


Tenga en cuenta estas fechas importantes:

SPIRITUAL ADOPTION OF UNBORN BABIES UPDATE—In January, many of our parishioners "spiritually adopted" newly conceived babies in danger of abortion by praying for them until their birth. Already these babies are 10,000 times larger than they were at conception. The baby is totally dependent upon his mother. Between mother and child lies the vital organ called the placenta. Here vessels from mother and baby intertwine without joining, highlighting this newly formed relationship, mutual, nourishing and deeply connected. Their spinal chords, brains and nervous systems are developing. At four weeks, the heart is already beating and pumping blood through the circulatory system. The babiy's arms, legs and eyes have begun to show. Please continue to pray for your "spiritually adopted" baby.
