LEGION OF MARY CELEBRATING IS 100-YEAR ANNIVERSARY

(St Brendan Praesidium celebrating 57 years Anniversary)

What is the Legion of Mary? Founded by Frank Duff at Myra House in Dublin, on September 7, 1921, the Legion of Mary has been active in the United States since 1931, endorsed by the Second Vatican Council. Legion of Mary sees its ministry as an organization for the laity to be an extension of the priest and takes as its mission "the glory of God through the holiness of its members developed by prayer and active cooperation in Mary's and the Church's work."

What does the Legion of Mary do? Members balanced program of prayer and service. Based on the Gospel, this service and may include parishioner visitation, visitation of the sick or aged, religious education, visiting the newly baptized, airport ministry, or meeting the other spiritual needs of the parish community. Legionaries are under the spiritual guidance of the pastor as an extension of his heart and hands.

Who can join? The Legion of Mary is open to all Catholics who: • Faithfully practice their religion; • are animated by the desire to participate in the Church's apostolate through membership; and, • are prepared to fulfill each and every duty which active membership in the Legion involves, including the obligations to daily prayer

How do I join? Membership is open to all baptized Catholics. After visiting a praesidium a few times, one can join the Legion as a probationary member. After which he or she has to decide whether to join the Legion as an active member permanently. Membership in the Legion of Mary is essentially based on discipline and commitment. Members devote their time and prayer for the intentions of Mary, Mother of God.


