### SPIRITUAL ADOPTION UPDATE-SIXTH MONTH—"I'm Sitting Up Straight Now!"

During the sixth month of life, our spiritually adopted pre-born babies will grow to 14 inches and increase in weight to about 2 pounds. The baby's oil glands and sweat glands are functioning: these help regulate body temperature. A white filmy layer covers the baby and protects their delicate skin from the surrounding amniotic fluid and from scratches as the baby twists and turns. This waxy substance, a sort of natural skin cream, will be quickly absorbed into the skin soon after birth. During the fifth and sixth month of life, the pre-born baby develops a very firm handgrip. It is even more powerful than that of an infant soon after birth. The baby can now respond to sound. The baby's lungs are fairly well developed and would stand a good chance of survival if born at this time.
