SPIRITUAL ADOPTION PROGRAM UPDATE-FIFTH MONTH "Mommy Felt Me Kick Today!" Our spiritually adopted babies are now five months old and the wonderful miracles of God's creation are so evident. This month marks the half-way point to birth, and the baby is very active. Sleep habits develop and his mother can feel him move and stretch, particularly when she is resting. He is big and strong enough to kick hard against the outside uterine wall and dent it. Up to now, although he swam with ease in his watery world, he was too small for her to detect because the inside wall of the uterus has little feeling. At five months hair and eyebrows begin to grow. Their ears are fully formed and they begin to respond to sound. They are able to hear their mother's heartbeat and voice. Many moms begin to sing to their babies at this stage.
