SPIRITUAL ADOPTION UPDATE—MONTH TWO—"I'M DANCING!" — Our spiritually adopted babies are now 8 weeks old and two inches. As early as 7 weeks, the nerve cells in the brain begin to touch one another. 100,000 new nerve cells are created every minute. Brain waves can be recorded by an EEG during this month. The baby responds to touch. If the baby's nose is tickled, she will flex her head away from the stimulus. The baby is developing all her external and internal organs. During the second month baby teeth form and her fingers and toes are developing. Ears, nose, lips and tongue can now be clearly seen. he skeleton changes from cartilage to bone. The central nervous system is now functioning and so forty muscle sets begin their first exercises. By 8 weeks all body systems are present and the baby is call a "fetus" a Latin word meaning "little one" or "young one." Ultrasound reveals that this little one can now spring and jump-her first dance steps! "Your hands have formed me and fashioned me. With skin and flesh you clothed me, with bones and sinews knit me together." (Job 10: 8, 11)
