

Ever hear about hippotherapy? This refers to a process by which individuals with physical and mental disabilities are treated using a horse. Specially trained physical, occupational, speech therapists utilize the natural gait of a horse to improve neurological and sensory processes in the patient, thus improving skills for daily life. Check out www.littlebit.org/blog to hear about actual cases where this therapy helped.

On **Wednesday, June 8**, we will be visiting **Little Bit Therapeutic Horse Center in Redmond**, which is one of the largest accredited therapeutic horsemanship programs in the US. We will be given an hour tour of the facilities as well as see both the Therapy & Adaptive Riding programs in action.



SPIRITUAL ADOPTION UPDATE: FOURTH MONTHS —"I Had A Dream Today"—There is a lot going on this month in the baby's development. The baby's brain has begun to mature-a process that will continue until about 14 years old. Nutrients consumed by her mother are passed on to her within an hour or two. Three hundred liters of fluid a day are sent to the baby via the umbilical cord. Fine hair begins to grow on her head, eyebrows, and eyelashes. Facial expressions similar to the baby's parents can be seen at this time. They sleep and wake regularly. This month REMS (rapid eye movements) have been recorded-a sign of dreaming. Their feet are perfectly shaped; nails and fingerprints are fully formed. Their entire body is

sensitive to touch and can feel pain. They swim freely and can turn somersaults. Vigorous activity shows distinct personalities. The babies can kick, turn their feet, make fists, move their thumbs and turn their heads. Their ears are developing and there is evidence that they can hear certain sounds— mom's voice and heartbeat and some internal noises.

Please continue to pray for these little ones. Before I formed you in the womb, I knew you. (Jeremiah 1:5)
