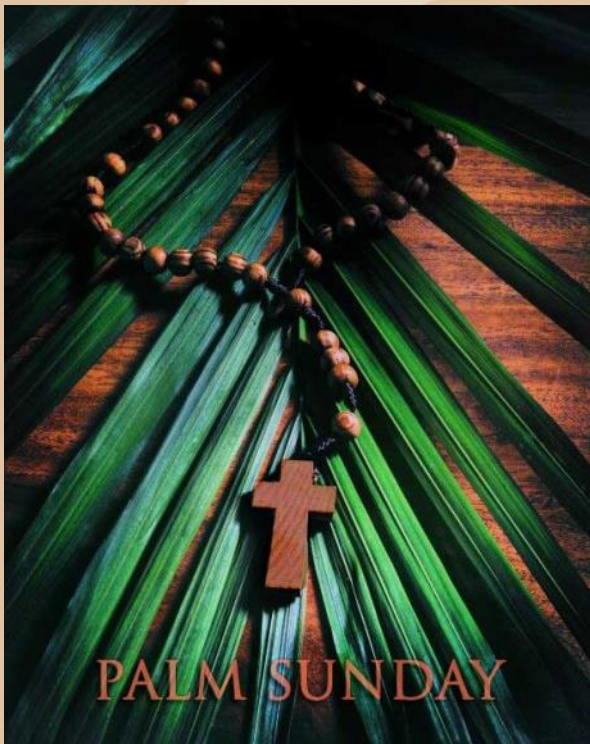

LETTERS TO COVID 19 VACCINE MANUFACTURERS

Although many of us who are eligible are obtaining vaccines, the USCCB has encouraged us to write letters to the manufacturers. We want to first of all thank them for their efforts, but also voice our opinions about the use of aborted fetal cell lines in the testing of the vaccines. (Pfizer and Moderna used the cell lines in testing, but Johnson & Johnson and Astra Zeneca used the aborted fetal tissue for the actual vaccine.) We have attached two letters to the online bulletin. Or if you attend Mass in person, printed copies will be on tables in the narthex where you may sign and send to the manufacturers.
