

SPIRITUAL ADOPTION UPDATE-FOUR MONTHS —"I Had A Dream Today"

The Baby's brain has begun maturing: a process that will continue until about 14 years old. Their feet are perfectly shaped; eyelids, nails, and fingerprints are fully formed. Their entire body is sensitive to touch, and they can feel pain. Their taste buds are now forming. Nutrients consumed by the mother are passed on to her baby within an hour or two. Three hundred liters of fluid a day are sent to the baby via the umbilical cord. Fine hair begins to grow on the baby's head. Facial expressions similar to the baby's parents can be seen at this time. The baby sleeps and wakes regularly, swims freely and can turn somersaults. Vigorous activity shows distinct personalities. The baby can kick, turn his feet, make fists, move his thumbs and turn his head. The baby's ears are developing and there is evidence they can hear certain sounds—mom's voice and heartbeat and some internal noises. This month REMS (rapid eye movements) have been recorded—a sign of dreaming. Please continue to pray for babies in danger of abortion.
