

UPDATE ON SOME OF THE PROJECTS IN NAMALAKA—The construction of the fence will be starting soon. This is a project that St. Brendan is helping to fund along with the parishioners of Namalaka. At the moment they are gathering some materials from the Church-

es since they were also asked to make contributions of remaining bricks and river sand. During the Projects Committee meeting, we agreed to make an extension of the fence so that it can be big enough. Instead of building a new house for the cook and his

family, the parishioners



are going to renovate an Mother Support Group serving porridge to learners at Lungwena Catholic Primary School. existing house near the maize mill. This will still have the cook significantly closer to the rectory.

We will also have a trip to Namalaka in August to visit our sister parish.

SPIRITUAL ADOPTION UPDATE—FIFTH MONTH — "Mommy felt me kick today" - Our spiritually adopted babies, who we have been praying for, are now five months old and the wonderful miracles of God's creation and life are so evident. This month marks the half-way point to birth, and the baby is very active.

Sleep habits develop and his mother can feel him move and stretch, particularly when she is resting. He is twelve inches now and big and strong enough to kick hard against the outside uterine wall and dent it. Although he swam with ease in his watery world, he was too small for her to detect because the inside wall of the uterus has little feeling. The baby's ears are fully formed and they respond to sound. They are able to hear their mother's heartbeat and voice. Many moms begin to sing to their baby at this stage. Babies born at this age have survived.
