PROGRESS IN NAMALAKA, SISTER PARISH, MALAWI, AFRICA

- 1) Thank you, ZIKOMO for project "Brendan Bowl", the name St. Joseph has given to the Monday–Thursday school lunch program that feeds 2,400 children porridge funded by special donations from St. Brendan parishioners. The St. Joseph community, who are taking ownership of the feeding project, feeds the children on Fridays which is a half day where they are dismissed from school to observe the traditions associated with the predominant culture of the Muslim religion. All are welcome at the Catholic school that is funded by the government.
- 2) The newly constructed rectory is progressing well. Fr. Chris, the pastor, reports "They have fixed the ceiling and soon the electricians will be wiring the house (a first for the village). We are also waiting for the plumber to fix the water system. Sincere gratitude for the donations and fundraisers from St. Brendan parishioners for the funds for this project. (total \$12,000). When finished, the house will accommodate visitors.

But not every neighbor lives near us. Jesus taught that everyone who needs our help is a neighbor.

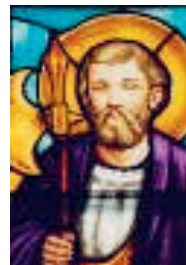
A Conversation between Abraham and God

En la ciudad de Sodom vivieron muchos pecadores. Dios iba a destruir la ciudad, pero Abram trató de convencerle a Dios que le daría una segunda oportunidad. Dijo, “Que pasa si hay 50, o 40, o 30 o 20 o 10 personas en la ciudad que son buenos?” Dios decidió de no destruir la ciudad.

Abraham heard that God intended to destroy the city of Sodom because of all the sin. He asked for God’s mercy, not justice. Abraham argued with God using subtraction. What if there were 50 good people, or 40, or 30, or 20 or 10? Would God save the city for those few people? (Read Gen. 18: 16-33)
