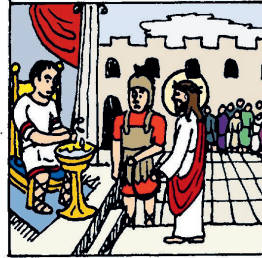
MALAWI MOMENTS, PALM SUNDAY

The people of Malawi in our sister parish of St. Joseph, in the village of Namalaka, have a saying "Chimanga Ndi Moyo" which translates "Maize is life". For 80% of people life revolves around growing enough maize(corn) to feed the family. There are three seasons of the year; the cold/dry season from May to August with temps from 60-82, the hot/dry season from Sep.-Nov., temps 62-93 and the growing seasons, the hot/wet time of year in Dec.-April when 95% of their rainfall occurs. All members of the family including the youngest children help plant, tend, weed, fertilize, pick and process. Drought and floods, a common feature of the country's climate, can spell disaster for crops. A successful harvest is cause for great celebration and joy. This year the harvest will begin this month and it is expected to be at near average levels—thanks be to God! There were very poor results in 2016 due to drought and 2015 due to floods. Stay tuned next week for more on the diet and culture of our brothers and sisters in Malawi. Immersion trips planned for August, 2017 and May, 2018. 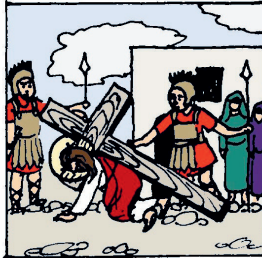

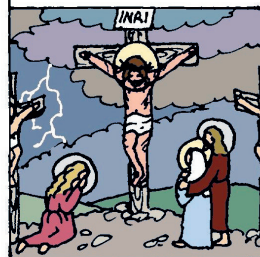
