#### MALAWI MOMENTS, EASTER SUNDAY, The Lord Has Risen, Alleluia!

Happy Easter from the Community of St. Joseph, Namalaka. To celebrate this joyous occasion our sister parish community in the village on the shores of Lake Malawi may enjoy chombo (fish & fish head—brain is the best part), mbuzi (goat) perhaps insects made into patties or toasted mice on a stick (a special roadside offering like "fast food"), Ndiwo (en-deewo), a relish made of beans, vegetables and meat, perhaps served with the staple food NSMA (en-seema) a thick maize porridge. They may also have rice, cassava and potatoes (fried and called "chips", sold at the roadside stands). The meal is eaten with hands and families wash as a communal bowl before and after the meal. Men are served first and then the women. We are very grateful to the St. Brendan community for the ongoing love and support to our brothers and sisters in Africa. 
