## MALAWI MOMENTS—How do they make Nsima (EN-seema) the staple food (cereal) of our brothers and sisters in Namalaka, St Joseph?

It is made with white cornmeal and water. The people are subsistence farmers, relying on a good rainfall for a successful harvest. The phrase "chimanga ndi moyo" means "maize is life". Maize flour is boiled with water into a porridge. It can then be "paddled" to create a thick paste, like polenta. Eating it is done by taking a small lump into one palm of the hand (no silverware), rolling it into a ball and dipping it into a relish made of vegetables and meat when available. An indentation in the ball can be made to help scoop up the relish. Traditionally at harvest time the maize (corn) is dried, sorted and pounded into flour. With the aid of a maize mill the corn can be easily ground much faster and easier. With our financial aid Namalaka will soon be installing power lines in the village that may then lead to a maize mill of their own.
