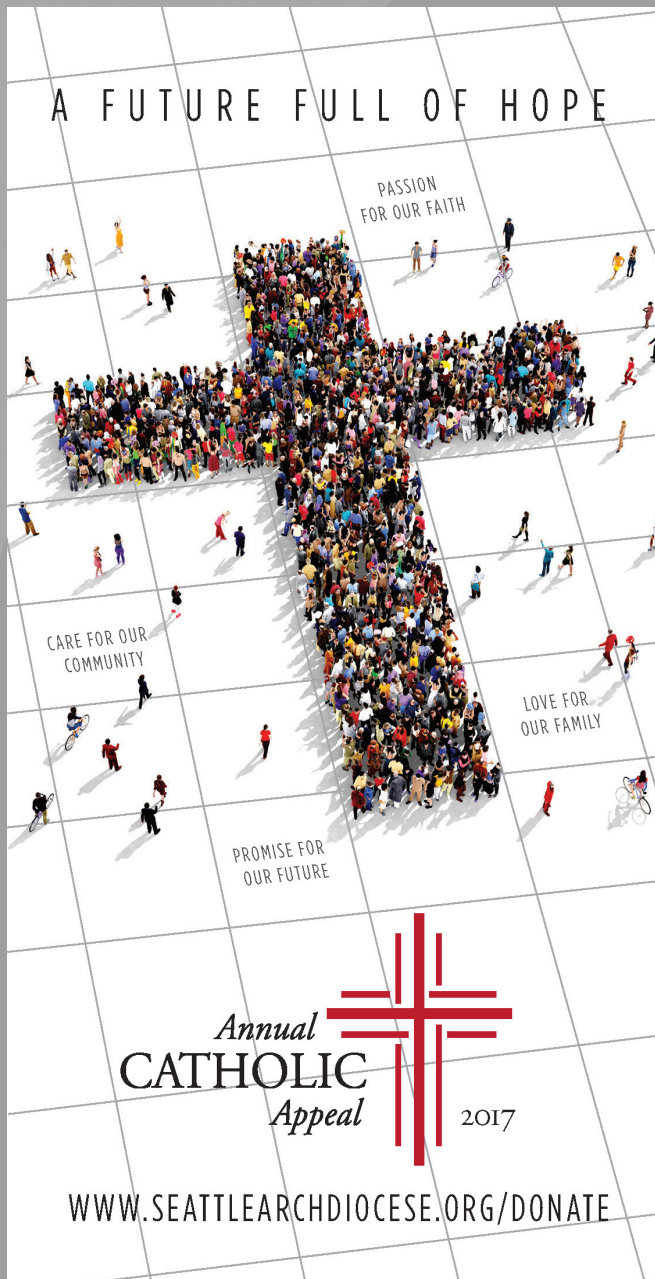

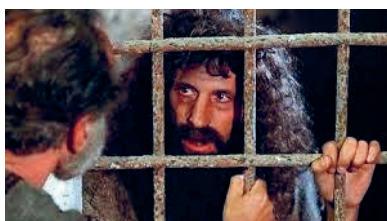
What a wonderful change had come over these two! Now they were glad to see each other. Esau completely forgave his brother Jacob.
