NAMALAKA ST. JOSEPH, MALAWI, AFRICA

Accomplishments:

- 1) Electricity Project—bringing power to village beginning in the new parish rectory, collected and sent \$11,500
- 2) School Lunch Program—"Brendan Bowl"; so far sent \$5,050 (costs \$2,400 per term) We have collected earmarked funds for Brendan Bowl totaling \$5,185 from parish at large and another \$4,205 from single donor in a matching fund challenge. When we raise another \$1,815 they will match the balance of \$2,800. Grand total will be \$14,000.
- 3) Delegation visit October 2016—\$5,400; we still have funds of \$6,140 earmarked to send to keep the lunch program ongoing.
- 4) Fundraisers: Giving Tree 2015: \$1800, 2016: \$1600/Auction \$8,500/Square Dance \$850/Fundraiser Dinner \$1,000/Jewelry Sale \$667/Bulletin & Poster "ASK" for Brendan Bowl \$9,390.


