Wouldn't it be great if you could just open a book that told you exactly what to do next? Or would it be better to open a book that tells you WHO can guide you?

Exodus chapters 5-11 The 10 Plagues of Egypt

Have you ever seen one of those movies where just about everything seems to happen? First there is a cave, and then there is an eagle, and then there is a fire, and then a long lost treasure—all made up for entertainment.
