# OLD TESTAMENT The First Passover Exodus 12: 1-28

Where do we get the word Passover? In Spanish the word Pascua means Passover, the same Spanish word that means Easter. But in English, Passover and Easter don't have the same name. England was a pagan country for a long time and many of the old words survive. Passover is a sacred Jewish holiday when the Jewish people remember that the Angel of Death "passed over" their houses. Living in Egypt they were constantly suffering from their condition of slavery. God took pity on his people, telling them to sacrifice a lamb—one for each family. They would paint the doorpost with the blood of the lamb, and that would be a signal to the angel of death to "pass over" their houses

# NEW TESTAMENT The Sorrowful Rich Man Matthew 19: 16-30

Almost everybody would like to be rich! People want to take care of their families and be comfortable. In the Gospel of Matthew we read about a young man who was rich, and his riches were causing him trouble. He went and asked Jesus, what he should do to receive everlasting life. Jesus knew from his questions that the young man really loved God and wanted to be close to God. Because Jesus knows everyone's heart, he could see the problem the young man was having. He loved being rich. and he didn't know how to care for the poor. Jesus gave him a great piece of advice. "Go sell all you have and give to the poor and then come, follow me," Let nothing come between us and following Jesus.

A couple of months ago Deacon Jose Blakely informed us of the serious illness he is facing. Obviously Dcn. Jose has not been able to be with us for a while now because of that serious illness. We have been praying for him in the intercessions at Mass over the past couple of months, but some parishioners have asked me how he is doing so I thought I would give a bit of an update. I spoke with him asking him if I could write something in the bulletin to update you all. He responded with a desire to let you know himself. I have copied his letter below.

"Dear Sisters and Brothers,

Lucy and I are deeply grateful for your constant prayers for my health and Lucy's strength at Masses, personal prayers, and in the faith groups you belong. I would like you to know God is answering your prayers as shown by the improvements in my condition, and ask you to persevere in praying for us, we need them.

Currently, I am on my 9th week at the Cardiac Care Unit at UW Hospital. Since I have been responding well to my treatments, I am being transferred today to a staging section of the hospital as an intermediate step prior to returning home in about a week, from where I can continue to receive my treatment as an outpatient.

This time of illness has been for me a time of purification, prayer, and personal growth. I have been offering my prayers and sufferings to those who suffer serious illnesses like mine; my doctors, nurses, and caregivers; the many people affected by natural disasters in Houston, Florida, Puerto Rico, and Mexico; and for all parishioners at St. Brendan Parish and School for unity of mission.
