#### **OLD TESTAMENT**

#### **The Gift of Manna**

**Exodus 16: 1-5** 

The manna in the wilderness has become one of the great encouraging stories of the Jewish and Christian faith. When the people of Israel escaped from Egypt and wandered in the desert, they missed the food they remembered from Egypt. When they complained to Moses, God gave them something called Manna. The word Manna sounds like the Hebrew words man hu, which means "What?" It looks like coriander seed, tastes like a plain cracker or wafer made with honey, and might even be related to the tamarind fruit. The Hebrews never forgot that God had provided for them out in the desert, although at the time they got tired of the same thing every day. Jesus said in John 6: 32, "It was not Moses who gave you bread from heaven...It was my Father."

#### **NEW TESTAMENT**

#### **Jesus Enters Jerusalem**

Matthew 21: 1-11

Every year, one week before Easter, we all gather to remember Jesus' entry into Jerusalem. Sometimes we borrow a donkey from someone's farm. Have you ever wondered why Jesus entered Jerusalem on a donkey? He had walked into Jerusalem many times, but this was a very different occasion. The prophet Zechariah had said, "Rejoice, oh daughter Jerusalem! See, your king shall come to you...meek and riding on a donkey."

It was traditional for the Hebrew kings to enter Jerusalem riding on a donkey. In 1 Kings 1: 33, David chose Solomon to be the next king. He said, "Take with you the royal attendants. Mount my son Solomon upon my own mule. Zadok the priest and Nathan the prophet are to blow the horn and cry, "Long live King Solomon!"
