OLD TESTAMENT

Balaam and His Donkey

Numbers 22-24

Balaam was a "seer." He received messages from God. A ruler named Balak wanted Balaam to help him with a situation. Balak was worried because the Hebrews were a large crowd of people who were moving through the desert all the way from Egypt into the land that we now call the Holy Land, Balak wanted Balaam to "curse" Hebrews. One day Balaam was riding on his donkey. Suddenly a huge angel stood in his path. The donkey moved out of the angel's way three times. Balaam was mad and started to punish the donkey. Finally the donkey started talking, "Am I not your own donkey?" At last Balaam blessed the Hebrew people instead of cursing them.

Matthew 25: 31-46
