OLD TESTAMENT

Women Can Inherit Land Numbers 27: 1-11

In Bible times, if a father died he left his land to the oldest son, or it went to the uncles. Five women named Mahlah. Noah, Hoglah, Milcah, and Tirzah took a stand that changed the law. Their father (Mr. Z) had died while the Israelites were still in the desert waiting to get to the promised land. When the land was being divided up among the families, someone probably said, "Well, let's give Mr. Z's land to one of his brothers since he didn't have any sons." It took a lot of courage for the five daughters to stand at the entrance of the meeting tent in front of everyone and say they should receive their father's land. Their brave actions caused the law to be changed so that daughters came ahead of uncles in the inheritance.
