MALAWI MOMENTS—News and Information on our Sister Parish Country

Did you know? Melinda Gates of the Gates Foundation (Microsoft) has been working in Malawi! She has fetched water with the women carrying 20 litres on her head. She spent time at a "homestay" working side by side with women who spend most of their day simply cooking and cleaning without the benefit of running water. The foundation is focusing on projects of healthcare promoting mother and child health, including safe births through training of midwives. Did you know? Madonna (singer) has adopted 4 children from Malawi and recently opened a new children's hospital in the city of Blantyre that has the first children's ICU in the country. She runs a non-profit called "Raising Malawi" that focuses on education. Did you Know? Malawi is home to 18 million people, the capital city is Lilongwe where 1 million live. The number of internet users in the country is only 9% of the population. The number of Facebook users is 4%. Life expectancy is 48 years for men and 51 for women. The poverty rate is 60%.

OLD TESTAMENT

What Was in the Ark of the Covenant?

1 Kings 8: 9 and Hebrews 9: 4

In 1 Kings 8:9 we read, "There was nothing in the ark but the two stone tablets which Moses had put there at Horeb, when the Lord made a covenant with the Israelites at their departure from the land of Egypt." In Hebrews 9: 4 we read that the ark was "entirely covered with gold," and that "inside the ark were the golden jar containing the manna, the rod of Aaron which had blossomed, and the tablets of the covenant."

Stone tablets: the 10 commandments

Manna: the food God gave his people in the wilderness Rod of Aaron: Moses and Aaron were of the tribe of Levi. Each leader of the 12 tribes gave Moses a staff. Aaron's staff grew leaves, budded, and even had almonds growing on it!

NEW TESTAMENT

The Great Commission

Matthew 28

Matthew tells the long story of the Passion of Jesus (trial, crucifixion, death and burial). He tells a short version of what happened after Jesus rose from the dead. Two women came to the tomb—Mary Magdalene and "the other Mary." They felt the earthquake and saw the angel. The angel told the women not to be afraid but to go and tell the good news to the disciples. Jesus met the women on their way. Everyone went to Galilee and there Jesus met them. He gave THEM and US the Great Commis**sion.** He told us to go over all the earth telling about Jesus, the Kingdom of God, and eternal life. He gave the apostles the authority to baptize "in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holv Spirit." Jesus promised to be with us always until the end of the world.
