OLD TESTAMENT

PREPARING TO CROSS THE JORDAN RIVER

Joshua 1: 1-3: 8

Before Moses died, he prepared Joshua to lead the Hebrew people. After wandering in the desert for an entire generation—about 40 years—the people were anxious to settle in their own homeland. We can now see in archaeological digs the kind of pottery they used and the kind of buildings they built. The Hebrews had moved from a life in Egypt to a life in the desert. They were about to start a new life in the land of Canaan. The Jordan River stood between them and their goal. Knowing that God had brought them here, they prepared to cross the river following the Ark of the Covenant, which contained the 10 Commandments, a piece of Manna, and the rod of Aaron.

NEW TESTAMENT

THE SYNAGOGUE AT CAPERNAUM

Mark 1: 21-28

A synagogue is a place of worship. The main place of worship for the Jews was the temple in Jerusalem. But Jerusalem was a long way from Capernaum. Hundreds of years before Jesus began his earthly ministry, the great temple of Solomon was destroyed, the last king was killed, and Jewish people were taken to Babylon. This is where synagogues were developed, places where Jews worshiped God by reading the scriptures and praying. Jesus came to the synagogue at Capernaum and began to teach. People were “spellbound” by his wonderful teaching. An evil spirit was living inside of a man. The evil spirit shrieked at Jesus, “What do you want from us? You are the Holy one of God.” At Jesus’ command, the evil spirit left the man. The people were amazed by this miracle.

LEARNING ABOUT OUR FAITH

The Human Person

There are billions of people in the world, more billions of people who have died, and many more people who will be born someday. With all those people around, it might be easy to forget how special we are, and how delighted God is with each of us. Paragraph 33 of the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* describes the **human person** as a human being who is made and loved by God. The human person is open to truth and beauty, has a sense of moral goodness, has both freedom and conscience, longs for true happiness, and is able to ask questions.

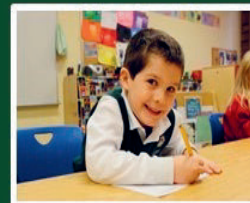
