OLD TESTAMENT

JOSHUA & THE BATTLE FOR JERICO

Joshua 5: 10—6: 16

Jericho is a modern city in the Palestinian Territories, located near the Jordan River in the West Bank. The city was founded more than 7,000 years before the birth of Christ. From ancient times it was surrounded by a wall. Joshua took the city in a battle which has become known as the Battle of Jericho. Why is this battle important to Christians? The story is very dramatic. Hebrew soldiers marched around the city following the priests with the Ark of the Covenant. They did this for 6 days. On the 7th day they marched around the city 7 times. A trumpet blew, the peoples shouted, and the walls came tumbling down. No matter how impossible a situation feels, just keep praying and trusting God. Pray for the “wall” of your problem to finally fall down.

NEW TESTAMENT

DOWN THROUGH THE ROOF!

Mark 2: 1-12

In many hot, dry countries, some houses are built with a flat roof. Stairs outside the house lead up to the roof. At night you can sit and gaze at the stars. During the day, it is very hot on the roof. In the time when Jesus walked among us, there was a group of friends who were trying to help a man who was paralyzed. Paralyzed people cannot walk. Hearing that Jesus was in Capernaum, they put their friend on a stretcher and walked over to Peter's house. But they couldn't get near Jesus because of the crowds. So they devised a plan to go up to the roof, remove a few roof tiles, and lower their friend, still on the stretcher, in front of Jesus. What a surprise! Jesus healed the man and also forgave his sins. The man stood up and walked!

BEATA means blessed. In Mark 5: 1-12 we read the 8 Beatitudes, a list of people who are especially blessed. They are the “poor in spirit,” who depend entirely on God; the sorrowful, the lowly, people who long for holiness, the merciful, the pure of heart, peacemakers, and those who suffer for Jesus.
