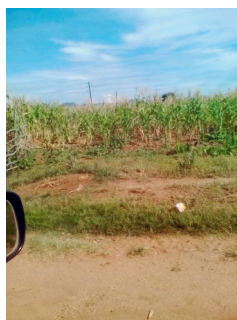

OLD TESTAMENT

GIDEON THE HERO

Judges 6: 1—7: 22

The story of Gideon is very famous because of three things. **First**, Gideon had a very interesting conversation with the angel who was sent to him. The angel said "The Lord is with you, mighty champion!" Gideon was pretty surprised at this, because at that time the Israelites were so scared of their enemies that they were hiding out in caves. The angel even allowed Gideon to ask for a sign. **Second**, God had an amazing way of choosing an army. He would only allow those who drank water by cupping their hands to the water to be in the army. **Third**, the army of God defeated their enemy by confusing them! The Israelites had simple trumpets, pottery jars, and torches. At a signal, they broke the jars, sounded the horns, and waved their torches. The enemies thought they were being attacked and fled into the night.

NEW TESTAMENT

THE MAN WITH THE WITHERED HAND

Mark 3: 1-6

We don't know why the man's hand was withered. He couldn't straighten it out and do daily activities. That probably meant that he couldn't work and had to depend on other people for food and shelter. But we do know that Jesus looked at the man with great compassion. Sometimes we think that God doesn't know our troubles. But actually, God knows all about what we are going through. Some of the people in the Bible narratives were healed in their bodies. Other people were not. In this case, Jesus touched the man's hand and immediately it straightened out. The religious rulers were angry with him for healing a man on the Sabbath day. Jesus was very sad that they did not have more sympathy for another human being.
