We believe he offered a ride to some men as is the custom when few own a truck and most folks have to walk. These men then attacked Fr. Saulos and stole his truck which was later found in a ditch. He suffered a broken upper arm and a head injury. He has since had surgery for the arm and has been released from the hospital. He is being cared for at St. Paul Seminary in Mangochi. He has no memory of the assault. We pray that he heals quickly and is able to return to the people of Namalaka as soon as possible. Our delegation visit is in just four months time. Questions? RUTH and NAOMI

Ruth chapters 3 & 4

In the Old Testament we see that women were a big part of the working world. We have read that Ruth worked to bring home food for herself and Naomi. They didn't wait for someone to bring food to them. Ruth's hard work and dedication won strong respect for her in the eyes of the community. Men worked very hard also. Men had the privilege, when their work was finished for the day, to sit in the city gate and talk about God's word, called the Torah. Also in the city gate, men would do their business transactions. Much like we make agreements with a handshake, in Bible times in Bethlehem a man would close an agreement by taking off his sandal. Boaz married Ruth by making a land deal agreement with one of her relatives. Sounds strange to us? Read Ruth chapters 3 and 4 and imagine yourself in those times.

NEW TESTAMENT THE WIND AND THE WAVES OBEY HIM!

Mark 4: 35-41

Does is ever seem to you like God is asleep? Have you ever prayed and prayed for a situation to be changed and you thought God wasn't listening? That's exactly what happened to the disciples one night. They were on the Sea of Galilee, where a violent storm can come up quite suddenly. If you've ever been on a boat when the waves splashed up over the sides of the boat. you can really imagine how the disciples must have felt when they found themselves in that sudden storm. They woke Jesus up, probably because they wanted him to help scoop up water out of the bottom of the boat. They never expected him to tell the wind and the waves to be still!
