1 Samuel 4: 4-5: 9

Mark 6: 34-44

Jesus was a great walker, so in following him sometimes people would find that they had wandered far from home and were very hungry. Jesus felt sorry for the people. The disciples had an idea. Why not dismiss the people and send them into nearby villages to buy food? But Jesus had a better idea. He said, "You give them something to eat." All they could find were five loaves of bread and two fishes. Jesus took the loaves and fishes, raised his eyes to heaven, blessed the bread and broke it, and then gave it to the disciples for the people. Everyone ate until they were full. The leftovers filled 12 baskets. Jesus had fed 5.000 men and their families.


