His arm is healing but not 100% yet and his memory of the incident causing the injury is unclear. Please continue to pray for health, recovery and return to ministry to the St Joseph community. He is sorely missed.

**GIVING CHALLENGE!!!** Thanks to the generosity of our parishioners, up to now we have been able to send funds to provide the children at the central village school with a daily bowl of maize porridge. We have been doing that for close to 2 years now at the cost of roughly \$2,400 per semester. We have a generous anonymous donor who wishes to give \$5,000 and has challenged us to match that with donations from the parish at large. Who knows, someday, we may be able to help and do so much more. Recently our neighbors at St. Theresa of Calcutta raised enough to build a church at a village in Africa that they have partnered with, at a cost of \$100,000. We can dream! #### **Old Testament**

##### **SAUL BECOMES THE FIRST KING 1 Samuel chapters 9, 10, 11**

The Israelites had demanded to have a king. The prophet Samuel was given the assignment to anoint the king. In those days a king was anointed with precious oil, much as we anoint people today in the Sacrament of Baptism. A man named Saul from the tribe of Benjamin had traveled to find some donkeys who had become lost in the hill country. Someone suggested that he should ask Samuel about the donkeys' location. God told Samuel that Saul was the one He had chosen. Saul was very shy. When his kingship was made known to the people he hid with the baggage. Nobody wanted him as king until the day when he won a great battle against the Ammonites.

#### **New Testament JESUS HEALS A DEAF MAN Mark 7: 31-37**

When Jesus returned to the Sea of Galilee he walked into the district of Decapolis, the Latin word for "Ten Cities." People brought to Jesus a man who was deaf and also could not speak. Jesus led him away from the crowd and touched both the man's tongue and his ears. He said the word "Ephphatha!" which means, "Be opened!" Right away the man began to speak and to praise God. As usual at that time, Jesus told people not to tell anyone, but everyone ran right off to tell what Jesus had done.

When adults or older children are going to be baptized, we have a rite called the Ephphatha Rite. We touch the ears of the catechumens while saying the word that Jesus spoke. This is a reminder to the new Christians that if they will listen, God will speak to them.

### **LEARNING ABOUT OUR FAITH**

#### **5 Kinds of Prayer**

All forms of prayer are important. **BLESSING** is a prayer when we ask the Holy Spirit to take something ordinary and make it holy. **Water is blessed for baptism. Ordinary people are blessed to become disciples of Jesus. PETITION** is when we ask for our own needs, such as food or spiritual blessings. **INTERCESSION** is when we pray for others. **THANKSGIVING** is when we remember to thank God for what He has done for us. **PRAISE** is when we tell God how much we love Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

## **SPIRITUAL ADOPTION UPDATE, FOURTH MONTH**

The baby's brain has begun maturing - a process that will continue until she is about 14 years old. Her taste buds are now working. Nutrients consumed by her mother are passed on to her within an hour or 2. Three hundred liters of fluid a day are sent to the baby via the umbilical cord. Fine hair begins to grow on her head, eyebrows and eyelashes. Facial expressions similar to the baby's parents can be seen at this time. This month REMS (rapid eye movements) have been recorded - a sign of dreaming.
