DAVID IS ANOINTED

1 Samuel 16: 1-13

David was the youngest son of Jesse. Saul—getting older and very troubled in his mind—wouldn't be king of Israel for much longer. So God sent Samuel on an errand to anoint the next king of Israel. Mark 8: 1-21
