David was happy that he had won his first battle, but there were other battles ahead of him. King Saul honored him at first for his victory. But as time went on the king became jealous. When they entered each town or village the women would come out singing songs that made David look better than Saul. From that time forward, David had to be careful for his life.

New Testament THE BOY POSSESSED BY DEMONS Mark 9: 14-29

When the Son of God was "incarnate" of the Virgin Mary, that means that the Son of God, without giving up any of his own divine nature, took on our human nature as well. Imagine how furious and helpless the demons must have felt! They swarmed into the holy land, inflicting their terrible illnesses and crises on the people who were the weakest, hoping to spread confusion and despair.

Jesus met many people who were possessed by demons. One worried father brought his child to the disciples. They couldn't cast out the demons.
