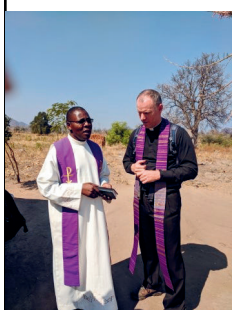

DAVID TAKES JERUSALEM

2 Samuel chapters 6 & 7

David was in Hebron when the people of Israel and Judah demanded that they wanted him as king. Historians estimate 1003 BC as the date when David established the kingdom in the new capital of Jerusalem, which is also called Zion, or the City of Zion. This city stands at a height that makes it good for defense. Also, the fact that people have to walk UP to reach Jerusalem reminds us of someday going to heaven. Many of the psalms are psalms of ASCENT, meaning that the people were chanting these psalms together as they walked UP-HILL to Jerusalem. Psalm 122 is a good example. “I rejoiced because they said to me, ‘We will go UP to the house of the Lord.’ Now we have set foot within your gates, O Jerusalem. Or Psalm 125, “They who trust in the Lord are like MOUNT Zion.”

THE DANGER OF RICHES

Mark 10: 17-31

A rich young man came to Jesus asking how he could have eternal life. Jesus answered the question by reminding the young man about the Ten Commandments. The young man was already following the commandments, and had done so all his life. What Jesus said next was such a surprise to the young man that “he went away sorrowful.” Jesus actually invited the young man to sell all he had and come and follow him. The man wasn’t ready to do that! It’s hard to give up riches to follow Jesus. We can’t help but wonder what happened to that young man. Did he finally—one day—give up his riches and follow Jesus?
