# Old Testament SOLOMON'S IS ANOINTED KING 1 Kings 1:11-53

Bathsheba was the favorite of David's many wives. Their son was named Solomon. Before David died, the prophet Nathan went to Bathsheba and told her that one of David's other sons, Adonijah, was planning to be crowned king before David's death. Bathsheba went to David and asked for their son Solomon to be king. David gave his blessing. At the same time, Adonijah had convinced a priest to anoint him king. He was already feasting with friends Zadok the priest, Nathan the prophet and other leaders loval to King David went to Gihon with Solomon. Solomon rode on the king's mule, which proved he had the king's blessing. Zadok the priest anointed him and all the people shouted "Long live King Solomon!" Adonijah ran for his life, but Solomon was merciful and told him to go home.

# New Testament JAMES AND JOHN ASK FOR TOO MUCH Mark 10: 35-45

The twelve disciples had mixed feelings about going to Jerusalem. Sometimes they were frightened, especially when Jesus told them what was going to happen therethat he would be killed and would rise on the third day. They couldn't understand what he was saying. At other times they were excited to go to Jerusalem because they thought Jesus would be crowned king, and that would make them very important. James and John decided that they were so important to Jesus that they should sit by his right hand and his left when he came into his kingdom. Jesus told them that place had been reserved for others. He reminded them to be humble servants, not proud rulers.

# LEARNING ABOUT OUR FAITH <u>The Hierarchy and</u> <u>the Magisterium</u>

According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church. Christ's faithful people are divided into several groups. depending on God's calling. We all participate in the Life of Christ who is Prophet, Priest, and King. One group is the Hierarchy. Peter was chosen to be the Rock of the Church, or Christ's Vicar on Earth. The apostles were each called to help lead the early Church. When they died, they were replaced by bishops. This is called the Apostolic Succession. Each large city had its own bishop. As the Church grew, we needed thousands of bishops, as we have today. Along with the priests, they are called to lead the Church in the servant ministry of Christ.


